- 1) Why Would I Add a Photo?
- Remember the person you once knew.
- Give others a chance to recognize your ancestor.
- Enrich the view of your ancestor, add to BMD, places lived, family etc.
- 2) Adding a Picture
- Photos should be G rated.
- Exclude duplicates, not-well-taken, or damaged.
- Scan ahead of time.
- Copyright photos can only be added with permission.
- Living persons—do not add except your minor children. Make private.
- Additions are screened.
- 3) Adding a New Photo
- 4) You can add a Tag & Details.
- 5) Audio files (MP3 & M4A format to 15 MB each)
- 6) You can create your own story & add it.
- 7) Try adding Portraits to Your Ancestors

The image is selected from that person's Memories or an uploaded photo.

- 8) Other Memories you can add:
- Multiple photos of a person, at various times in his/her life.
- Documents that provide details about their life: birth; marriage; or death.

- A photo of the home where he/she lived at various times in his/her life.
- 9) Example—Wenzel Shamal's death certificate.

10) Your Gallery

- 11) Each time you add a Memory to anyone, it's deposited in your Gallery.
- 12) You have access from Family Search > Memories > Gallery.
- 13) Your Gallery has a capacity of about 6,000 & three basic divisions:
- 14) **Memories**—recent additions on which you're working
- 15) Once done, right click and add to your archive.

17) Recently Deleted

- Will permanently delete after 120 days.
- 18) Albums
- Allows you to group pictures how you wish.
- Example—by families and/or surnames.
- Any memory can be in multiple folders.
